Tania Ellis CSR - so what's the bottom line?

On Friday last, Tania Ellis led us into the world of Corporate Social Responsibility and Sustainability in a carefully crafted three -part presentation that proved to be both highly entertaining and informative.

Beginning with an analysis as to why companies, both large and small, decide to take on a socially responsible position or role, Tania offered three core reasons - compliance, business opportunity or conviction.

Enriching her talk with both well known and many new names, at least for many of us, in the CSRworld she illustrated her three ideas. Beginning with Nike and its detractors of a few years ago, she explained about how they had been forced by consumers and the media to take on a more responsible role in terms of their manufacturing.

Turning to multinational industrial giant General Electric and their ecomagination-strategy, which focuses on developing green technological solutions, she highlighted the fact their sustainability initiative was launched, "not because it's trendy or moral, but because it will accelerate our growth and make us more competitive."

Moving into her third theme, she talked about Patagonia, an outdoor clothing manufacturer, who in quoting the company president provides an excellent example of CSR by conviction, *'I'm not in the business to make clothes. I'm not in the business to make more money for myself.... the reason why I'm in business [is] to try to clean up our own act, and try to influence other companies to do the right thing.'*

Adding to this example, was perhaps the one I liked best, Greystone Bakery known for hiring those normally not considered employable, addicts and convicts, reflected in their motto... "We don't hire people to bake brownies. We bake brownies to hire people."

Having clearly defined social responsibility and provided some heartwarming examples that fit into her three compliance objectives, she quickly reviewed the benefits firms enjoy once they have decided on and implemented a business strategic CSR strategy and not just a greenwashing project here and there.

She dealt with these various benefits and discussed ideas ranging from differentiation from others to enhancing one's reputation; from adding to employer branding to encouraging operational efficiency; from becoming a preferred supplier for other social responsible firms to finding new customers and markets; and finally from motivating innovation to being able to encourage both economic and social growth.

A thoroughly enjoyable talk, I noted a number of people near me looked positively ecstatic that they now had a genuinely will-informed idea about what CSR and sustainability mean along with examples they could share with others.
